New Hymns Coming in November

In November we will start introducing hymns from All Creation Sings, a supplement to the hymnal Evangelical Lutheran Worship, the red book we use. There will be a new hymn or song each week for each service.

All Creation Sings was published by the ELCA in 2020, to support the ongoing renewal of worship as it responds to fast-paced changes in church and society. The book was somewhat overlooked because it appeared during the COVID pandemic. A few individual songs have been used in Alpine services, but we will be making an organized attempt to introduce these songs to the congregation. There are new hymns written by living composers, new words set to familiar tunes, new tunes using familiar texts, and songs being added to the Lutheran hymnal from other sources, such as "Deep River" and "Oh, When the Saints Go Marching In." Some hymns are suitable for playing on organ, while others are better for use with the praise band.

A few hymn books have been purchased and are available to anyone who wants one to sing along. Those who like singing with a hymn book may like to keep one near their seat. If we need to order more, please let Lynn know. Those who would like to purchase copies should contact Lynn in the office. The purchase price is \$15.50 per book. There are enlarged print and e-book editions available as well.

Lyrics for the new songs will be included in the slides for the first service as well as for the second. Band and choir members will be learning the songs to help other congregation members. Hopefully some of these songs will become your new favorites. Remember that "Amazing Grace" was new once! And it didn't really catch on until after the words written by an Englishman in the 1700s were paired with a tune published in America in 1835.
